Located on the waterfront in Old Town Alexandria for almost 40 years, Chadwicks offers traditional American food – burgers, sandwiches, salads, soups, and more – in a warm, inviting atmosphere. Chadwicks will provide us with individual checks, but, as a precaution, please bring enough cash in smaller bills (ones, fives, and tens) to cover your check and gratuity. We may not be able to expand our reservation, so do not hesitate to RSVP. Note that we will probably be seated upstairs (Chadwicks has no elevator).

We are hoping to continue our New Year's Day tradition, weather permitting, of walking to Market Square to see the beautifully decorated huge Christmas tree after our meal.

LOCATION: Chadwicks is at 203 Strand Street, Alexandria, VA 22314 (https://www.chadwicksoldtown.com, 703-836-4442). There is plenty of on-street and facility parking nearby; a pay parking lot is across the street from the restaurant. The free King Street Trolley provides easy access from the King Street Metro Station on the Blue and Yellow Lines.

DIRECTIONS: From I-95/I-495 (Woodrow Wilson Bridge/Northern VA) – Take Exit 177 (Route 1 north) using the local lanes and follow the signs to Alexandria. You should be on Patrick Street. After the light at Franklin Street, go four blocks and then turn right onto Duke Street; go nine blocks, cross Union Street, and then turn left onto Strand Street. The restaurant will be on the left.

January 6, 2026, Tuesday, 1:30 PM: Square Dancing at Greenspring Village

Afterwards, our Spiritual Advisor will bless the incoming Council in the small chapel at the back of the church. After the Mass and the blessing of the Council, we will have lunch at a restaurant to be determined.

LOCATION: Church of the Nativity is at 6400 Nativity Lane, Burke, VA 22015.

DIRECTIONS: From I-395 or the Beltway (I-95/I-495) – Take Exit 1B (I-395 South from Arlington/Alexandria), Exit 169B (I-95/I-495 from Woodrow Wilson Bridge), or Exit 57A (I-495 South from Tysons Corner) to Springfield onto Old Keene Mill (OKM) Road (Route 644 west). Proceed almost 6 miles, cross Lee Chapel Road (bearing slightly left to stay on OKM Road), go about 0.2 mile, and look for the church on the right, at 6400 Nativity Lane, Burke, VA 22015. If you miss the first entrance, there is a second entrance about 100 yards farther on OKM Road.

January 13, 2026, Tuesday: RSVP for January 14 Walk at Rutherford Park

January 14, 2026, Wednesday, 11:00 AM: Walk at Rutherford Park

Walk on the Long Branch Trail at Rutherford Park in Fairfax. Our knowledgeable PTSC member will lead us on the trail which is mostly paved and level, scenic, and easily traversed. We will meet in the parking lot at Rutherford Park, cross Guinea Road, and walk east on the trail.

DIRECTIONS: From the Beltway (I-495) – If coming from Springfield and points south, take Exit 54A, Route 620/Braddock Road west. Go about 2.5 miles and then turn right onto Guinea Road (Route 651). Proceed about 0.7 mile to the Rutherford Park sign and parking lot on the left. If coming from Maryland or Tysons, take Exit 52A, Route 236/Little River Turnpike west. Go about 1.8 miles and then turn left onto Guinea Road (Route 651). Proceed about 1.4 miles to the Rutherford Park sign and parking lot on the right.

DIRECTIONS: Take the Franconia-Springfield Parkway (Route 289) to Spring Village Drive. Once on Spring Village Drive, go to the stop sign, then proceed straight ahead to the Greenspring Village gatehouse. Tell the guard that you are going to the dance at the Village Square building. Then, after stopping at two stop signs, turn right and go all the way down the hill; the Village Square building will be directly in front of you. Park for free in any of the visitor spaces in the nearby parking lots.

DIRECTIONS: From I-395 or the Beltway (I-95/I-495) – Take Exit 1B (I-395 South from Arlington/Alexandria), Exit 169B (I-95/I-495 from Woodrow Wilson Bridge), or Exit 57A (I-495 South from Tysons Corner) to Springfield onto Old Keene Mill Road (Route 644 west). Proceed about six miles; turn right onto Lee Chapel Road; cross Burke Lake Road; (Lee Chapel Road becomes Burke Center Parkway here); go another mile and then turn right onto Burke Commons Road. Turn left into the shopping center (there is another shopping center on the right). Walmart will be on your right. Go to the end of the Walmart garden center. Villa Bella is in the strip of businesses on the left.

DIRECTIONS: From the Beltway (I-495) – Take Exit 47A, Route 7/Leesburg Pike west. Go about 18 miles (you will pass Route 28) until you reach the cloverleaf exit for Claiborne Parkway (Route 901 south). (NOTE: If using the Fairfax County Parkway/Route 286, take Route 7 west and after about 7 1/2 miles you will come to the Claiborne Parkway cloverleaf.) Proceed about four miles on Claiborne Parkway, cross the Dulles Greenway, and then turn right at the light onto Broadlands Blvd. Go about 0.4 mile, and the entrance to Clyde's will be on the right.
