October 5, Sunday, 10:15 a.m.: *Mass at St. Louis Church / Poor Clares Monastery Visit*

After the 10:30 a.m. Mass at St. Louis Church in Alexandria, we will visit the nearby monastery of the Poor Clares. (Meet us in front of the church at 10:15 a.m.) In 1977, the Poor Clares came to our diocese at the request of Bishop Welsh. According to the Arlington Herald, they are "a praying heart in the diocese," receiving many requests for prayers every day. The order was founded by St. Clare and St. Frances of Assisi on Palm Sunday in the year 1212. Of course, we can't go inside the monastery, but we can see it from outside and there is a chapel we can enter.

Directions: From the Beltway (I-95/I-495) – Take Exit 177, Route 1, south toward Ft. Belvoir (you must be in the local lanes on or near the Wilson bridge). Go about two miles and look for Beacon Center (large shopping area) on the right at the top of a hill. At four blocks past the end of the shopping center, turn left at the second light (lights are very close together) onto Popkins Lane. The church will be on the right.

Directions: From I-395 or the Beltway (I-95/I-495) – Take Exit 1B (I-395 South from Arlington/Alexandria), Exit 169B (I-95/I-495 from Woodrow Wilson Bridge), or Exit 57A (I-495 South from Tysons Corner) to Springfield onto Old Keene Mill Road (Route 644 west). After passing under a bridge, turn right onto the next street (Bland Street). At the next light, turn right onto Amherst Avenue to cross over Old Keene Mill Road. Immediately after the first light, look for the American Legion post on the right. Use the main entrance on the first floor; turn right for the Warrior Cafe.

Go about 18 miles (you will pass Route 28) until you reach the cloverleaf exit for Claiborne Parkway (Route 901 south). (NOTE: If using the Fairfax County Parkway/Route 286, take Route 7 west and after about 7 1/2 miles you will come to the Claiborne Parkway cloverleaf.) Proceed to the first light and turn right onto Aspen View Blvd., then take the next left onto Belmont Chase Drive. Go about 0.1 mile and the restaurant will be on the left and the parking lot on the right.

October 15, Wednesday, 11:00 a.m.: Walk at Leopold's Preserve in Broad Run, VA

Join your fellow PTSC walkers at this 380-acre privately owned preserve that is open to the public and is part of the Virginia Bird and Wildlife Trail. The preserve has diverse habitats with scenic overlooks and historical sights. Please note that the site has no running water or waste cans; there is one portable toilet in the public parking lot, so please plan accordingly! Following the walk, and at the discretion of the attendees, we can dine at a nearby restaurant.

Location: 16290 Thoroughfare Road, Broad Run, VA 20137 (www.leopoldspreserve.com).

Directions: From the Beltway (I-495) – Take I-66 west, then Exit 40 for Haymarket/Route 15. Keep left to go onto Route 15 south. Turn right onto Route 55 west (John Marshall Hwy.), go almost two miles, and then turn left onto SR-682/Thoroughfare Road. Go for 0.3 mile (the paved road turns to gravel, and you will cross railroad tracks). Look for the public parking lot on the left where we will meet (Parking Lot East).

October 18, Saturday, 10:45 a.m.: Tour of Rippon Lodge Historic Site / Walk to Follow

Join us for a guided tour of Rippon Lodge, one of the oldest homes in Prince William County. Take this chance to visit a home and setting that has been around since 1747. The building began as a colonial dwelling with restorations throughout the years resulting in today's Colonial Revival building. Cost of the tour is \$5.00. After the tour, we'll drive downhill for a scenic walk on the Neabsco Creek Boardwalk, which stretches 0.625 mile over tidal wetlands. Lunch will follow for those interested. NOTE: Please be sure to meet us by 10:45 a.m., as the tour will start promptly at 11:00.

Directions: From the Beltway (I-95/I-495) – Take I-95 south to Exit 156, Dale Boulevard, toward Rippon Landing. Follow Rippon Boulevard across Jefferson Davis Hwy/Route 1. Turn right onto Blackburn Road. Travel 1/4 mile and turn right onto Admiral Black Drive. If you take Route 1 from the Beltway, follow Route 1 for about 20 miles, turn left onto Rippon Blvd., right on Blackburn Road, and right onto Admiral Black Drive.

At the end of the ramp, turn left onto the Eisenhower Avenue Connector (if coming from Alexandria, turn <u>right</u> onto the connector). After 0.2 mile, turn right onto Eisenhower Avenue. Go about two miles, pass over Telegraph Road, and then at the second light, turn left onto Hoffman Street. Take the second left onto the circle; the restaurant will be on the right. If there is no parking in front of Ted's, continue on the circle to the sign for additional parking at Carlyle Towers.
